PARC PARTNERS AND COURTNEY SHUPE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



PARC AND SHUPE PROGRAMS

Designed to assist people whose families or households face economic challenges, in using Kirkwood Parks and Recreation facilities.

To qualify, individuals or their household must be eligible for one of the following programs:

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Aid to Dependent Children
- Section 8 or other housing assistance program
- Medicaid, MC+ or Medical Assistance for Families (MAF)
- Title I meal support program
- Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI)

Participants must be residents of Kirkwood (Glendale or Oakland resident for aquatic activities only).

Each Eligible Child receives one recreation program per year at 50% off.

HOW TO USE THE PARC & SHUPE PROGRAMS

Applications are available at the Community Center front desk or at kirkwoodmo.org/pool.

Return the completed form, with the requested documentation to Kyle Henke, 111 S. Geyer Rd., Kirkwood MO 63122.

Your application will be reviewed, and you will be notified as to your standing in the programs. If accepted, you will be given a free PARC/ Shupe membership that is valid for three years. You will be issued a Kirkwood Resident ID card. Upon presenting this card at the Pool, Ice Rink or Tennis Courts you will be given the 50% PARC/ Shupe discount.
