### COMMITTEE MINUTES

May 28, 2014

Minutes approved with addition of Kids Day report from May 28 meeting, which was progressing smoothly.

**LOGO DISCUSSION:** After reviewing two renditions of possible logo it was decided that the 2014 seemed to stand out more than the "54" logo. The artist would later send an example that made the "54" in white at top of logo and it seems to work.

**BROCHURE/WEBSITE:** Work was beginning on the Greentree Festival web pages. Murray Pounds asked committee if they have things to include on respective pages in 2014 from last year to send to him. As more detailed information comes in the web pages will continue to be built.

**SHUTTLE:** In its seventh year, the shuttle continues to be a fantastic service to the Greentree Festival. Is there a demand for a Friday night shuttle? Dave Hufford (and First Student) can make it happen. Since the Motown Revue is so heavily attended, another bus might be scheduled. Should rain be in forecast, a second bus can be called off.

**ARTS AND CRAFTS:** Committee leaders walked with Murray Pounds over A&C area, added booths where they could now fit and re-worked map. Fifteen booths will be lost from 2013 with expansion of tennis courts and refurbishing of area now covering what was the top row of booths. The good news is that there will be 180 booths. Spaces were added behind Information Booth. Some new vendors wanted the area of two booths but had to be denied. Three booth spaces no longer available.

**CAR SHOW** Mike Keehn is awaiting logo to design what will be given away.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Steve Knapp reports the crowd pleasing side-by-side fire will return.

**KIDS DAY:** Kristen Docter reported that Bobaloo, Bubbles and Ronald McDonald will all be making appearances. Young people with School of Rock will be performing Saturday and Sunday with own instruments. A double slide and bounce house will be on site, as will Toddler Town. Checking on a face painting area and also an "amazing" caricature artist. Awaiting a proposal from G2 Sports.

**POLICE:** Jim Cox will have additional information as Greentree draws closer.

**MUSIC:** Bob Mosby reported two youth bands will be performing and that he scored a coup with the addition of Miss Jubilee and the Humdingers on Saturday afternoon. Along with the band, the Lindy

Hoppers swing dancers will also perform Sunday's lineup will include the bands Falling Fences, Thin Dimes and Cree Rider. A tarp for shading or rain for the stage area was discussed. Look for the Lucille Rapp Dancers to be performing at the Amphitheater.
