A work session of the Kirkwood City Council was held on March 5, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor McDonnell, Council Members Biedenstein, Jaksetic, Griffin, Luetzow, Sears, and Ward. Also in attendance were Chief Administrative Officer Russell Hawes, Assistant Chief Administrative Officer Georgia Ragland, and Public Information Officer Beth von Behren. City Clerk Betty Montañó was absent and excused.

APPROVAL OF WORK SESSION MINUTES

Motion was made by Council Member Jaksetic and seconded by Council Member Luetzow to approve the meeting minutes of February 26, 2015. The motion was unanimously approved.

THE GREAT RACE

The Great Race Special Event Permit Application applicant Kirk Hutchison was in attendance to present and discuss the details of The Great Race. Some of the discussion included:

- History of the race and background information was given.
- The Great Race is a vintage auto timed race with vintage cars ranging from 1972 or older.
- The race will take place from June 20th through June 28th, 2015.
- Cars will start arriving in Kirkwood on Wednesday, June 17th.
- There will be approximately 120-125 cars.
- The race will start in Kirkwood at the Kirkwood Train Station on June 20th with cars lining up along Argonne between Kirkwood Road and Taylor at 8:00 a.m. A presentation will be made at 9:00 a.m. and the by 10:00 a.m. the cars will start leaving.
- The race is not a race for speed. It is a race for time.
- Expecting anywhere between 3,000 to 10,000 visitors to Kirkwood.
- The cost to hold the race in Kirkwood is \$25,000, which was paid for by a sponsor.
- Any money raised and left over during the event will be donated to the Kirkwood Train Station restoration project fund.
