# PARC and Shupe Programs

The two programs are designed to assist people whose families or households face economic challenges, in using Kirkwood Parks and Recreation facilities during public use times. Opportunities include use of the aquatic center, tennis courts, ice rink and community center gymnasiums.

To qualify, individuals or their household must be eligible for one of the following programs:

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Aid to Dependent Children
- Section 8 or other housing assistance program
- Medicaid, MC+ or Medical Assistance for Families (MAF)
- Title I meal support program
- Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI)

Participants must be residents of Kirkwood (or a Glendale or Oakland resident for aquatic activities only).

## How to Use the PARC & Shupe Programs

Please contact the administrator of the programs, Louise Marcolla, at the contact number listed below. All inquiries and correspondence regarding the PARC programs will be held in the strictest confidence.

If you believe you qualify for the programs, please request an application. Return the completed form, with the requested documentation to his attention at the address provided.

Your application will be reviewed, and you will be notified by mail as to your standing in the programs. If accepted, you will need to get a PARC Partners ID card, similar to the ID cards issued to Kirkwood residents.

The cards are issued free of charge, and are good for the current calendar year, plus the next calendar year. Upon presenting this card at any of the facilities listed to the left, you will be given the user rate as indicated.
