



## *Sign Up For Kirkwood Emergency Alerts and Notifications Today!*

The City of Kirkwood has implemented a new high-speed emergency notification system—called **CodeRED**—that will help us reach you in the event of an emergency or a situation needing your immediate attention.

### **This is a completely voluntary system.**

That means that to receive notifications, you must “opt-in,” or register. It also means you can opt to receive alerts via phone, text, or email. OR all three! YOU choose!

### **You can “opt in” in one of two ways:**

- 1) Visit the City Website at [www.kirkwoodmo.org/CodeRED](http://www.kirkwoodmo.org/CodeRED).  
Read more about the program, and click on the logo at the bottom of the page to be re-directed to the CodeRED enrollment page.  
It only takes a few minutes to opt-in.
- 2) If you don't have Internet access, you can call CodeRED directly at 1-866-939-0911, and they will walk you through the registration process.  
OR call City Hall at 314-822-5894 for assistance.

**Typical emergency alerts might include:** Boil water alert, earthquake, tornado, train derailment, foreign or domestic terrorist attack (bombing, shooter, etc.), flood, chemical spill, major road closure, other National Weather Service warnings (ice storm, major snow), and mass civil unrest or disturbance. These events may be related to other things such as major power outages, significant water main breaks, massive fires, or other issues. The messages the City sends can provide additional information related to these occurrences.
