Landmark SAVED!



This beautiful Italianate style home at 419 East Argonne Drive was unoccupied and in danger of demolition. The Landmarks Commission assisted the new homeowners with design advice to save their home.

Did you know Historic Preservation is sustainable development?

- Reuse of existing buildings and materials produces fewer environmental impacts than demolition or new construction.
- Demolition ships waste material to landfills.
- The manufacturing of materials for new construction uses higher energy output than preservation of existing structures.
