WORK SESSION MINUTES

APPROVAL OF THE FEBRUARY 1, 2024 and February 8, 2024 WORK SESSION MINUTES

Motion was made by Council Member Duwe and seconded by Council Member Zimmer to approve the February 1, 2024 and February 8, 2024 Work Session minutes. The motion was unanimously approved.

COMMUNITY CENTER ROOF COLOR

Chief Administrative Officer Russ Hawes discussed the Roof color with Council. Construction is underway. The existing roof color is old fashion and needs to be replaced. Christner Architects recommends changing the color to a light gray/blue with the mechanical screen the same color. The screen over the Theater will match the Gym roof and ice Rink roof. The Roof screen is not currently in the budget, but there is no cost difference.
