Notice is hereby given to all interested persons that a public open house meeting will be held in-person in Room 200 at the Kirkwood Performing Arts Center, located at 210 E Monroe Ave, Kirkwood, MO 63122, on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, from 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. Horner & Shifrin, Inc., the City's Engineering consultant, will not be making a formal presentation at the in-person public meeting; however, they will be on hand to answer any questions. Handicap access is available. All interested parties will be allowed to submit comments regarding the design of the Grant's Trail Extension, Phase 1 Project. The public can find additional information on the city's website at www.kirkwoodmo.org/projects. The Grant's Trail Extension, Phase 1 Project will consist of the following improvements:

- Reconstruction and widening of the Union Pacific Railroad crossing of South Taylor Avenue
- Two-way Concrete Trail
- Pervious Pavers
- Pedestrian Guard Rail Decorative Fence (4-Foot Tall)
- Northbound South Taylor Bike Lane
- Removal of on-street parking on the east side of South Taylor Avenue
- Covered bike parking; Various Bicycle and Pedestrian Furnishings
- Concrete Entrance and Pavement
- Raised Concrete Crosswalks and Intersection at East Monroe Avenue / South Fillmore Avenue
- Select Enclosed Storm Sewer System Modifications
- UPRR Control fencing and signage

Preliminary plans, maps, plats, environmental documentation, and other detailed information prepared by the City of Kirkwood's engineering consultant (Horner & Shifrin, Inc.) will be available at the public meeting.

Horner & Shifrin, Inc. will discuss the tentative schedules for easement acquisition and construction at an open-house-style format.
